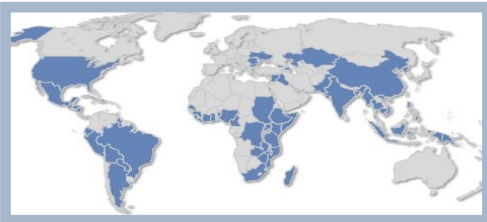

Care Convoy Shipment

Care Convoy out of Jerome, Idaho, dropped by Monday September 9th with three large Penske Trucks. We loaded a total of 13,473 pounds of medical equipment worth over \$100,000. Todd Jaynes from Care Convoy stated that the equipment will be taken to Jerome and shipped to three different countries—Mexico, Ecuador, and Liberia.

Crisis Care Kits Shipment

Hurricane Dorian devastated everything in its path including key towns in the Bahamas, like Marsh Harbor. In response, Hands of Hope NW teamed with Nazarene Compassionate Ministries (NCM) and Convoy of Hope who are trucking 1,066 cases of Crisis Care Kits (CCKs) from our warehouse to Florida. There they will be added to NCM's existing CCKs and emergency supplies and shipped to those in need in the Bahamas.
