Ukraine Shipment

On October 16th, we loaded three 40-foot shipping containers with medical supplies and equipment headed to Ukraine. This was the first time that we had loaded more than one container at a time. We are grateful to our crew and to the many volunteers who work hard to ensure we can help people around the world and at home. Channel 2 and Channel 6 came on site to film this important shipment.













The total value of this 3-container shipment is worth \$933,000 and will help the Ukrainian army and civilians care for those with medical needs as the conflict rages on.

A couple of days earlier, a Ukrainian representative, Roman Romanov, visited our warehouse to look over the loads prepared for the shipments. During the two-hour visit, we had a conference call with a member of the Ukraine Parliament and discussed how Hands of Hope NW can continue to assists Ukrainians during their time of great need.



We value your support which allows these local efforts to touch lives in countries we may never visit and in ways we could never plan or imagine. Only God could orchestrate this amazing ministry!

Please pray that the containers reach their destination and that the equipment and supplies arrives at just the right time.

Amazing how fast a year can go by! It has been a record-breaking year at Hands of Hope. We have already shipped over 3 million



dollars worth of medical equipment and supplies, including a large shipment in November (not reflected in the stats). This is a combination of loaning or giving equipment to local individuals, equipping free local clinics, supplying missions trips, and shipping full 40-foot containers and smaller loads.

We are continuing to work on sending shipments to Ukraine and are currently working on our sixth shipment to Ukraine for the year. The need there is great.

Warehouse Manager, Mark Pridgen, and his crew loaded 3 containers at the same time in under 2 hours! It was truly amazing watching them work and get the job done.
