Guatemala Update: Expanding Mobility and Independence

We're excited to provide an update from our partners at Transiciones Guatemala about the tremendous work being done thanks to the equipment and prosthetics sent last year. The impact of these donations has been significant, as they've brought mobility, independence, and a renewed sense of dignity to hundreds of individuals.

Between January and May, Transiciones Guatemala served 1,315 individuals who sought their assistance. This number is spread across the multiple services they offer, ranging from wheelchair provision to physical therapy and prosthetic care. Here's a closer look at the amazing work accomplished during this time:

- 1,037 services were provided across the various clinics operated by Transiciones Guatemala, making a tangible difference in people's lives.
- Wheelchairs have been the most requested item, with 147 units distributed to those in need. The Transiciones factory, which custom builds wheelchairs for various posture needs, manufactured and delivered 74 of those wheelchairs.
- The physiotherapy clinic has been instrumental in helping 87 patients regain mobility, delivering a total of 712 physiotherapy sessions.
- The prosthetics and orthotics clinic has also been a lifeline for many, serving 176 patients and providing 46 of them with essential prosthetic or orthopedic items.

Despite the progress, the need remains high. Currently, 65 individuals are on the waiting list for wheelchairs, while 54 patients are awaiting prosthetics. This underscores the importance of continued support for these life-changing services. Thank you for being a part of this mission and helping us continue delivering hope and mobility to those in need in Guatemala. Your donations truly make a difference—and we're ready to ship again!
