In the early 1990s, Sharon Griffith noticed something that didn't sit right with her: usable medical supplies were being discarded while people—both locally and around the world—went without basic care and equipment. Hospitals and clinics were throwing away items simply because they could no longer be used in certain settings, yet these same supplies could mean dignity, healing, or mobility for someone else. What began as a simple but bold question—*what if these supplies were given instead of thrown away?*—became the spark for a mission that has now spanned three decades.

That single act of compassion grew into an organization built on stewardship, generosity, and trust. What started small—collecting and redistributing surplus supplies—has become a highly coordinated effort involving staff, volunteers, donors, and partners working together to ensure medical equipment and supplies reach those who need them most. Today, those early decisions continue to shape everything that happens, from the way equipment is repaired and sanitized, to how shipments are prepared and partnerships are formed.

Over time, the mission expanded in two powerful directions: serving neighbors close to home while also responding to needs far beyond our borders. Locally, families facing sudden illness, injury, or financial strain have been able to access durable medical equipment at no cost, easing both physical and emotional burdens. Internationally, clinics, hospitals, and medical missions have been equipped to provide care in places where resources are scarce and access is limited. This dual focus—local compassion and global responsibility—has become a defining strength of the organization.

The impact of that original idea can be measured in numbers, and those numbers tell a powerful story. In recent years alone, millions of dollars' worth of medical supplies and equipment have been recovered and put back into service rather than wasted. Families have saved hundreds of thousands of dollars through local lending and giveaway programs. Clinics, hospitals, shelters, and mission partners—both in Idaho and across the globe—have received the tools they need to provide care in challenging circumstances. Each statistic represents lives improved and resources used wisely.

But the lasting impact goes far beyond the data. It lives in the everyday moments: a staff member watching anxiety turn into relief when someone realizes help is available; a volunteer finding purpose in repairing a wheelchair or packing a box; a donor choosing to give, knowing their generosity will directly serve others. It's seen in recipients—children able to attend school because they're healthy enough to learn, patients receiving treatment through mission clinics, veterans and seniors regaining independence at home. These stories, repeated thousands of times over the years, form the heart of the mission.

That same spirit continues to guide the organization forward. As shipment requests increase, local needs grow, and global challenges evolve, the work remains rooted in the same values that shaped its beginning: compassion, responsibility, and action. The vision ahead is not only about expanding reach, but about strengthening systems, deepening partnerships, and ensuring that every donated item fulfills its highest purpose.

What began as one person's decision to see possibility where others saw waste has become a legacy shared by many. It is a legacy carried by staff, volunteers, donors, and partners—past and present—who believe that small, faithful acts can create lasting change. As the mission looks toward the future, that founding idea continues to light the way: serve with intention, steward with care, and never underestimate the impact of choosing to give.


Looking Ahead
