Much of this work happens quietly, away from the spotlight. In warehouses, offices, and loading docks, volunteers and staff give their time to ensure every item is handled carefully and responsibly. Their efforts may go unseen, but their impact reaches far beyond these walls.

The heartbeat of this mission is the people who show up week after week. Volunteers sort supplies, repair equipment, pack shipments, welcome visitors, and ensure every item is safe and ready for use. Each task, no matter how small it may seem, plays a vital role in meeting real and urgent needs.

Every volunteer brings something unique—skills, stories, and a shared desire to help others. Together, they form a community united by compassion and purpose. It is this collective effort that turns donated supplies into life-changing support for individuals and families.

This work is also powered by people who believe deeply that

dignity matters. Donors give generously, partners place their trust in the mission, and volunteers give freely of their time. Together, these acts of service create a ripple effect—one that reaches neighbors here at home and communities across the globe.

Papua New Guinea Update

In November of last year, our team of dedicated volunteers carefully packed medical supplies into a 20-foot shipping container bound for Papua New Guinea. After months in transit, that container has safely arrived at Nazarene Health Services, where the supplies are now being distributed to support patient care in rural communities.

To get supplies to our partnering healthcare providers in Papua New Guinea, a 20-foot container is used instead of a 40-foot container due to the rugged terrain and limited access in many areas. Each container must be hand-stacked to maximize space

and ensure the load can be transferred onto trucks capable of navigating remote roads. Every box is placed with intention, knowing the journey it must make once it reaches its destination.

We are deeply grateful for the opportunity to continue serving the people of Papua New Guinea alongside trusted partners. Even now, volunteers are busy packing supplies for another shipment, with hopes of sending the next container this spring—continuing to deliver care, compassion, and hope where it's needed most.
