Fundraising Goal for the Philippines

Our May 1 Open House was a huge success! You helped us raise \$9,520 towards our \$15,000 goal for a shipment of medical supplies to two Christian Birthing Homes in the Philippines: Shalom Christian Birthing Center and Shiphrah Birthing Home.

Thanks to all of you who gave, including the \$3,000 matching grant donors and the two Filipino groups who cooked such delicious food! This mercy shipment will help save babies' lives, and support safe, dignified maternity services for women living in squatter villages in one of the poorest areas of the world.

Here's how you can impact lives:

- \$25 buys medical supplies for one birth
- \$50 purchases five blankets
- \$100 equals 10 boxes of other necessities for mothers and babies

Shalom Christian Birthing Home will be one of the beneficiaries of the shipment. They care for 400 mothers and deliver an average of 130 babies a month.

He was a missionary physician in Swaziland for eleven years. The physicians rotated through all the departments so he knows what would be useful to hospitals and clinics in other countries. His parents were missionaries in China and he lived there from 1936-1941, until they were forced to leave because of the war. He is married to Leonie, who is an Associate Professor in the nursing department at Boise State University. His hobbies are hiking, kayaking, and fishing and he

enjoys going on short term mission trips. While in Swaziland he ran a 54 mile marathon three times! Thank you Dr. Paul for your heart of service and for sharing your expertise!
